


#### Wroclaw at a glance





- 638 000 inhabitants in Wroclaw
- 1 000 000 inhabitants in the agglomeration
- Approx 3 000 000 inhabitants in the region of Lower Silesia (borders with the Czech Republic and Germany)
- Wrocław the 3rd biggest academic centre in Poland
- R&D the main specialization of Wroclaw according to ABSL report
- 5.1% unemployment rate

#### Strong transport links



New bypass (A8) crosses the A4 motorway (Germany-Ukraine), connects with national road no.8 (Czech Republic-Warsaw) and with national road no.5 to Poznań

First Polish city incorporated into the **European highway system** 

Rapid development of Wroclaw airport & great opportunities for industries

 Well developed road, railway and waterway infrastructure means lower travel times

## Wroclaw International Airport 2nd biggest Polish airport



- 10 km away from the city centre
- Major European transfer hubs:
  Warsaw, Munich, Frankfurt and
  Copenhagen



- Wroclaw's new terminal: the capacity of the airport will double by 2015 to **7 million passengers a year**
- New bypass connecting the A4 motorway with the airport




