Work Plan of the EUROSAI Task Force on the Audit of Funds Allocated to Disasters and Catastrophes for 2012-2014

Acknowledging the attained results of the EUROSAI Task Force on the Audit of Funds Allocated to Disasters and Catastrophes activity and the importance of the developed materials for the practical activity of European public accountants, as well as realizing the necessity of further completion and approval of the final version of Good Practice Recommendations for the Audit of Funds Allocated to Disasters and Catastrophes, the VIII EUROSAI Congress in June, 2011 has taken decision on the extension of the EUROSAI Task Force mandate for the next three-year period to 2014.

This Work Plan sets out the strategic Goals and proposed activities of the EUROSAI Task Force on the Audit of Funds Allocated to Disasters and Catastrophes for the period between VIII and IX EUROSAI Congress from 2012 to 2014 according to its Terms of Reference.

The EUROSAI Task Force Mission is to coordinate and consolidate the efforts of European SAIs towards increasing their awareness of the disasters and catastrophes and to help governments develop the effective and efficient instruments of disasters and catastrophes prevention and consequences elimination

In order to achieve its vision, EUROSAI Task Force will work towards the following strategic goals:

Strategic Goals:

- 1. Encouraging joint, coordinated and parallel audits of funds allocated to prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes within the framework of EUROSAI Task Force.
- 2. Developing the methodology in the field of auditing funds allocated to prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes, also capacity building of SAIs in this sphere.
- **3.** Enhancing the collaboration and setting up new contacts between SAIs within the framework of the EUROSAI Task Force activities, facilitating the information sharing between European SAIs and training in the field of audits of funds allocated on prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes.
- **4.** Developing a common approach and coordination of the efforts with INTOSAI and EUROSAI working groups and bodies, as well as other international organizations.

Expected results

- **1.** Maintaining a database of the audits of natural and man-caused disasters in Europe.
- **2.** Updating of the glossary of terms on auditing the funds allocated to prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes.
- **3.** Conducting of the audits of the funds allocated to prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes within the framework of EUROSAI Task Force.
- **4.** Completion and approval of Recommendations of the good practices on the Audit of Funds Allocated to Disasters and Catastrophes.

Strategic Goal 1: Encouraging the conduction of audits

Goal

Encouraging joint, coordinated and parallel audits of funds allocated to prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes within the framework of EUROSAI Task Force.

Rationale

As the results of the EUROSAI Task Force activity have shown, much of the audits in the sphere of prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes are international. This confirms both the transboundary nature of consequences of catastrophes and necessity of co-ordinated joint activity of governments in this sphere and joint control over efficiency of this activity, effectiveness and legality of utilization of allocated funds.

Thus, it is planned to conduct international coordinated and parallel audits on themes which will be the most urgent for EUROSAI Task Force members in the framework of the EUROSAI Task Force activity in 2012-2014.

Strategic goal 2: Methodology Development and Capacity Building.

Goal

Developing the methodology in the field of auditing funds allocated to prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes, also capacity building of SAIs in this sphere.

Rationale

In order to fulfill Strategic Goal 2 it is contemplated continuing work on generalization of experience in the sphere of carrying out audits of the prevention, occurrence and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes, replenishment of audit database and update of Glossary of terms for audits conducted in the field of prevention and consequences elimination of disasters.

On the basis of the further experience of EUROSAI Task Force members on carrying out of audits of funds allocated for prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes, it is proposed to carry out completion of Recommendations of the good practices on the Audit of Funds Allocated to Disasters and Catastrophes in few stages according to amendments and suggestions of SAIs – members of Task Force EUROSAI.

Strategic goal 3: Setting up new contacts and information sharing between European SAIs

Goal

Enhancing the collaboration and setting up new contacts between SAIs within the framework of the EUROSAI Task Force activities, facilitating the information sharing between European SAIs and training in the field of audits of funds allocated on prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes.

Rationale

Information sharing between SAIs for carrying out audits of funds allocated for prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes is a main result of EUROSAI Task Force activity. The Task Force activities and, first of all regular Task Force meetings, are the basic tool of information sharing and an opportunity to develop cooperation with others SAIs and independent international organizations.

During its mandate period the EUROSAI Task Force will inform about the results of its activities on regular basis in the INTOSAI and EUROSAI printed and electronic editions (INTOSAI Journal, INTOSAI WGEA Greenlines, EUROSAI Newsletter etc), as well as permanently report to the EUROSAI Governing Board on the progress made.

Additionally, it is planned to introduce on continuing basis the exchange of experience between interested SAIs through, in particular, information sharing and training activities during the EUROSAI Task Force meetings, as well as running a separate web-page on the EUROSAI Task Force at the web-site of the Accounting Chamber of Ukraine.

EUROSAI Task Force intends to continue cooperation in this field, and, particularly, with the INTOSAI and EUROSAI Working Groups on Environmental Auditing and the INTOSAI Working Group on Accountability for and the Audit of Disaster-related Aid in terms of further promoting the consolidation of efforts of the international SAI community to contribute to preserving safe environment for the people in Europe, exchanging work plans, audit plans, methodology and findings in the field of environmental auditing and the auditing of disaster-related aid, as well as developing guidelines and recommendations on the audits of the prevention of disasters and catastrophes.

EUROSAI Task Force plans to draw external expertise from international, and in particular European, institutions and organizations dealing with the issues of ecological safety and environmental protection, especially in the field of the prevention and consequences elimination of disasters and catastrophes.
