LVIV DECLARATION OF COOPERATION AND PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN

THE ACCOUNTING CHAMBER OF UKRAINE AND

THE SUPREME AUDIT OFFICE OF THE REPUBLIC OF POLAND

The Accounting Chamber of Ukraine, represented by Mr. Valerii Patskan, Chairman,

and

The Supreme Audit Office of the Republic of Poland, represented by Mr. Krzysztof Kwiatkowski, President,

hereinafter referred to as "the Parties"

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT the existing friendly cooperation among the Parties and the common values that they share;

CONSIDERING the willingness of the Parties to strengthen close relations among them;

RECOGNISING the important role of constant development of professional and effective state auditing and the independence of Supreme Audit Institutions as a fundamental element of a democratic state;

WILLING to establish and develop a regular dialogue on international issues of mutual interest;

DECLARING to strengthen the relations already existing, in the forum of the International Organisation of Supreme Audit Institutions – INTOSAI and the European Organisation of Supreme Audit Institutions – EUROSAI, as well as bilateral cooperation;

CONVINCED that this Declaration will provide the basis for new initiatives in the area of cooperation among the Parties;

HAVE DECLARED THE FOLLOWING:

Article 1

The Parties declare their willingness to continue and develop their friendly bilateral cooperation.

Article 2

The Parties will strive to exchange their experience in the field of auditing and support one another in the process of improving the independent state auditing.

Article 3

The Parties will strive to communicate effectively within their <u>capacities</u> (mandate) to the benefit of the international community of SAIs.

Article 4

The Parties will strive to conduct together, (also with participation of the Supreme Audit Offices of States – members of the EUROSAI), international coordinated audits in the following spheres, which are recognized, as of special importance.

- environmental protection and prevention and elimination of catastrophes:
- a) International Coordinated Audit on the Status of Compliance with the Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and their Disposal (follow-up audit);
- b) International Coordinated Audit on Protection of the Waters in the Bug River Catchment Area from Pollution (Follow up Audit);
- c) International Coordinated Audit of Transboundary East Carpathian Biosphere Reserve
- science and innovations;
- social politics and protection of citizens rights and freedoms.

The Parties will identify topics for possible international coordinated/parallel audits.

Article 5

The Parties will strive to cooperate in developing and further implementing of a long-term support program for institutional development of the Accounting Chamber of Ukraine, inter alia in the framework of EU programs and funds; in particularly for establishing in Ukraine of the Training centre for the Accounting Chamber.

Article 6

The Parties intent to conduct joint seminars in the years 2018-2019 concerning the institutional development of both SAIs and implementation of ISSAI.

Article 7

Details of the outlined activities will be provisionally coordinated by the Parties.
